LGBTQ students face terrifying levels of bullying and harassment in our schools More than 40% of our LGBTQ students have seriously considered suicide Only one third of Florida school districts have policies to protect LGBTQ students

Florida's LGBTQ youth face enormous risks which greatly reduce their chance of success in school, including family rejection, bullying, physical/sexual assault, homelessness, substance abuse, and suicide.
